- 74° 41' west longitude
- 375' elevation
- USDA plant hardiness zone 6b

The Willowwood Arboretum is the former country estate of Henry and Robert Tubbs and is situated on 130 rolling acres in north-central New Jersey. Started in 1908, the arboretum is comprised of formal and informal gardens, and natural meadows and woodlands. The diverse collections contain trees, shrubs, and herbaceous plants from temperate regions around the world, some of which were collected by E.H. Wilson in China in the early 1900's. The arboretum was later the site for research conducted by Dr. Benjamin Blackburn.

The Willowwood Arboretum is a facility of the Morris County Park Commission, which serves the people of Morris County, New Jersey, through the protection of open spaces and natural areas, conservation, and the preservation of historic sites. The Commission operates 37 facilities, cares for over 17,000 acres, and offers a variety of recreational and educational programs.
